Descriptions

Identify your level of integration by finding your score in the key below.

Score Key		
Level of Integration	Score Range	Description
Strong integration	50-75	You are actively engaged in campus and faculty activities and are regarded as a valued member of the Mico community.
Weak integration	26-50	You are somewhat engaged in campus/faculty activities. You are "seen" on the campus but not in a very substantial way.
Poor Integration	0-25	Little or no integration means that you are a remote member of the community and not actively engaged in faculty/campus activities.

^{*}Note: Scores above are based on the statistical approach called "variable weighting" where a number (weight) is assigned to each data item to reflect its relative importance based on the objective of the data collection.
